\_\_\_\_\_ Serve Your Unit. The Ordeal Member has maintained his/her registration in scouting and has served his/her unit during a period of at least 10 months since his/her Ordeal Ceremony.

\_\_\_\_\_ Plan for Service in Your Lodge. The Ordeal Member has Paid his/her dues and pledge future service to the lodge.

\_\_\_\_\_ Review Your Progress. The Ordeal Member shall write a letter to the Lodge Secretary which contains the following information;

- Explain what you think the Obligation means.
- Describe how you have been fulfilling this Obligation in your unit and daily life and how you have used your understanding of the Ordeal to aid in your service, and
- Describe your specific plans for giving future service in the lodge program.
